Composition:

Each 5 ml syrup contains Thiamine Hydrochloride BP 5 mg, Riboflavin Sodium Phosphate BP 2.74 mg equivalent to Riboflavin 2 mg, Pyridoxine Hydrochloride BP 2 mg, Nicotinamide BP 20 mg & Zinc Sulphate Monohydrate BP 27.5 mg equivalent to elemental Zinc 10 mg.

Description: Biozinc-B is a special preparation of zinc and B-vitamins.

Indications and uses:

Biozinc-B is indicated for the treatment and prevention of B-vitamins and Zinc deficiencies in infants, children & adults.

Dosage and administration:

Adults: 10 ml (2 teaspoonful) 2 to 3 times daily or as recommended by the physician. Children: 10 ml (2 teaspoonful) 1 to 3 times daily or as recommended by the physician. Infants: 5 ml (1 teaspoonful) 1 to 2 times daily or as recommended by the physician.

Side effects: Biozinc-B is generally well tolerated. Use in pregnancy &lactation: Recommended.

Contraindications: Biozinc-B is contraindicated in patients with a known hypersensitivity to any

of the ingredients of this product.

Drug interactions: Generally no interactions have been observed.

Overdosage: In case of overdosage, initially epigastric pain, diarrhea & vomiting can occur. Should seek emergency medical attention in case of overdose. Initially an emetic should be given and then gastric lavage and general supportive measures should be employed.

Storage: Keep in a cool and dry place, protect from light.

Presentation: Each bottle contains 100 ml syrup with a plastic spoon.
