SODIUM CHLORIDE; POTASSIUM CHLORIDE; SODIUM BICARBONATE; DEXTROSE ANHYDROUS; SUCROSE; FRUCTOSE

Compositions:

Each sachet contains Sodium Chloride- 0.44 gm, Potassium Chloride - 0.38 gm, Sodium Bicarbonate - 0.42 gm, Dextrose Anhydrous – 4.09 gm, Sucrose – 8.07 gm, Fructose - .07 gm, Flavour- Qs.

Pharmacology:

Unisalene Fruity flavored Oral saline. Oral rehydration therapy is a treatment for the symptoms of dehydration.

Dosage And Administration:

The amount of water removed from the body, equivalent quantity of mixture should be given. After each loose motion... Children below 2 years : 50-100 ml (10-20 teaspoonful) prepared saline. Children between 2-10 years : 100-200 ml (20-40 teaspoonful) prepared saline. Children above 10 years and adults : 200-400 ml (1-2 glass) prepared saline.

Warning And Precaution:

ORS should not be mixed with hot water and the mixture should not be heated. The mixture must be discarded after 12 hours from preparation
