

Side Effects:

Rabeprazole are generally well tolerated. The most common adverse events are headache, abdominal pain, diarrhea, rash, dry mouth and nausea etc.

Use in Pregnancy and Lactation:

Pregnancy category B. Use in Nursing Mother: Since many drugs are excreted in milk, and because of the potential for adverse reactions to nursing infants from Rabeprazole, a decision should be made to discontinue nursing or discontinue the drug, taking into account the importance of the drug to the mother.

Drug Interaction:

Possible interaction with Warfarin, cyclosporine, ketoconazole, Iron salts, digoxin, Mycophenolatemetofil, Atazanavir, methotrexate.

Overdosage:

There is no experience with large over dosages with Rabeprazole. The maximum reported overdose 80 mg. There were no clinical signs or symptoms associated with any reported overdose. Patients with Zollinger-Ellison syndrome have been treated with up to 120 mg Rabeprazole once daily. No specific antidote for Rabeprazole is known.

Storage:

Store in a cool (below 30°C) and dry place, protect from light. Keep out of reach of children.
